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New members to join existing ERNs soon

The call for new members to join existing ERNs is now closed. ERN ReCONNET received 38 applications from 14 countries.

The assessment of the application consists of several steps. First, the European Commission will conduct an **eligibility check** of all submitted applications. Then, the Board of the ERNs will have to assess all the **eligible applications** for their Network. The applications with favourable ERN decisions will be then forwarded to the **Independent Assessment Body** that will conduct an additional assessment. The final phase is the **formal approval** of each candidature by the ERN Board of Member States, which will take up to two months. It should be emphasized that the final number of new members will only be known at the end of the whole assessment process, which is expected to be **at the end of 2020**.

The geographical coverage of the ERNs already underwent a

first phase of enlargement earlier this year, with the inclusion of "<u>Affiliated partners</u>" between June and November 2019. Designation process concluded within the launch of the ERN 2019 call. 10 Member States designated 14 Affiliated Partners for ERN ReCONNET.

Expert Panel Consensus Meeting on Patient Pathways

The Expert Panel Consensus Meeting on Patients Pathways was held in Pisa on 27th and 28th October 2019. The meeting outlined the current practice in the organization of rCTD care in the ERN ReCONNET centres and the patients' perspective on their pathway, establishing the basis for the implementation of the pathways for all the diseases covered by ERN ReCONNET.

During the Expert Panel Consensus Meeting on Patients Pathways the book "ERN ReCONNET Systemic Sclerosis Patient's Stories" was presented. This is the result of the collection of stories through a questionnaire held in Autumn 2019 among over 200 European Scleroderma patients.

ERN ReCONNET webinars
