ERN ReCONNET ePAGs translated the Fai2R recommendations

ERN ReCONNET has endorsed the Filière de Santé des Maladies Auto-immunes et Auto-inflammatoires Rares

(Fai²R) **recommendations** for treatment of patients with autoimmune or auto-inflammatory diseases during COVID-19 pandemic.

Thanks to the commitment of ERN ReCONNET **European patients advocacy groups**, the recommendations have been translated into 16 languages, and adapted by Fai²R. The same has been done with the suggestions on **How to live better** during the containment period.

ERN ReCONNET has realised some infographics based on the recommendations.

COVID-19 Clinical Management Support System

The European Commission launched the COVID-19 Clinical Management Support System with the aim to support clinicians in hospitals that are currently facing the coronavirus emergency all over Europe. Based on the experience with the European Reference Networks, the initiative helps to create rapid connections across Europe among the hospitals indicated by the Member States as reference centres for COVID-19. Clinicians can rely on a dedicated helpdesk managed by DG SANTE to set up web conferences and exchange with their peers in Europe on possible treatments, and on how to handle severe and complex cases.

Assessment of ERN ReCONNET new applicants suspended

The examination of membership applications for existing ERNs is suspended from 1 April 2020 to 31 August 2020. Due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, the efforts of healthcare providers and health professionals in the Union are fully devoted to addressing the ongoing public health crisis. As a consequence, the Commission decided to suspend the on-going evaluation process to allow health care providers to fully dedicate to the management of the sanitaria crisis, and at the same time preserving the evaluation of the applications from disruptive consequences. The examination process will resume on 1 September 2020 and the suspended time limits will continue running from that date.

European Commission webinar on COVID-19 and Rare Connective Tissue and Musculoskeletal diseases and conditions

In the context of the "COVID-19 Clinical Management Support System" launched by the European Commission, DG SANTE organises a series of webinars to support clinicians and other healthcare professionals at the frontline of the care of COVID-19 patients. These webinars bring the expertise and recommendations of several experts from the 24 ERNs in the management of challenging cases of patients suffering at the same time of COVID-19 and a rare or complex disease or conditions.

The <u>European Medicines Agency</u> (EMA) will waive all fees for scientific advice for academia developing **orphan medicines** to further encourage the development of treatments for rare diseases.

EMA decided to include academia in the list of organisations eligible for free protocol assistance as of 19 June 2020. Eligible applicants will include public or private **higher education establishments** awarding academic degrees, public or private **non-profit research organisations** whose primary mission is to pursue research, and **international**

European interest organisations. These entities should not be financed or managed by private for-profit organisations in the pharmaceutical sector or have concluded any agreement with pharmaceutical companies concerning their sponsorship or participation in a specific research project for which a fee exemption is sought.


