



The **Clinical Patient Management System (CPMS)** is a secure web-based application to support European Reference Networks (ERNs) in the diagnosis and treatment of rare or low prevalence complex diseases or conditions across national borders.

The **CPMS** enables clinicians to enrol patients who have given consent for their data to be shared on the virtual platform, and to collaborate actively by using comprehensive data models.

The **CPMS** provides a crucial tool for rare disease patients enabling healthcare professionals across Europe to discuss clinical cases in a **safe environment**.



THE ERN ReCONNET NATIONAL HUB

serves as national contact point to support the usage and dissemination of the CPMS at national and local level

serves as national reference contact for specialists, general practitioners and other healthcare professionals in each country in order to provide information on the functioning of the platform

contributes to connecting even the more remote healthcare providers and patients to highly specialised services of the ERN ReCONNET

Each **National Hub** enables a wider diffusion of the **CPMS** potentialities and of the **CPMS** usage, making the **CPMS** service available for a larger number of patients, even for those living in less accessible areas, far from reference centers.
