ERN ReCONNET Scientific Congress & Plenary Meeting



The **First Scientific International Congress of the ERN ReCONNET** took place from *20th to 22nd April 2023* in Brussels, right after also the **ERN ReCONNET Plenary Meeting** was held from *22nd to 24th April*.

The Congress was a *unique opportunity* for all the ERN ReCONNET members to interact with the multiple stakeholders of the rare and complex connective tissue and musculoskeletal diseases community and to discuss innovative approaches while fostering collaborations across Europe. The brainstorm exercise spanned over several relevant key points, such as: *Epidemiology of rCTDs, ERN ReCONNET Points to Consider for treating ARDs patients with antiviral therapies and antibody products anti-SARS-CoV-2, Diagnosis and clinical management of rCTDs, Biobanking and registries, Quality of life of rCTDs, Organisational and economic aspects of rCTDs, Therapeutic management of rCTDs, Comorbidities, Innovative approach of clinical studies in rCTDs.*

Moreover, two special “*Meet the experts*” appointments on “*Pregnancy in rare and complex connective tissue diseases:*

patients and physicians point of view” with the *ePAG Silvia Aguilera* (Elche, Spain) and *Prof. Marta Mosca* as well as on “*Ehlers–Danlos syndromes*” with *ePAG Charissa Frank* (Beringen, Belgium) and *Dr. Fransiska Malfait* (Gent, Belgium) were held.

In addition, **ERN ReCONNET** was very proud to have received *82 scientific posters* from its scientists and researchers.

Regarding the **ERN ReCONNET Plenary Meeting**, the event took place in person after 3 years of pandemic and it was an amazing experience as we finally met in person the new members of **ERN ReCONNET** that joined in 2022 and we have also seen the amazing work that is being organized by all the *Working Groups and Disease Groups*. The discussions held were very precious to reflect on the new governance and of course also to discuss the exciting proposals collected during the *Network Cafè*, which was a great success and that might be repeated also in our future meetings.

Results of the ERN ReCONNET Evaluation



The **ERN ReCONNET Network evaluation** reported an *outstanding level of performance in accomplishing all the planned objective*. The Evaluation can be considered as a huge success with a *full 100% compliance with Network criteria*.

The Evaluators reported that **ERN ReCONNET** has developed an excellent level of maturity regarding its purpose,

governance, leadership, learning, and sustainability. According to the external evaluators, the approach adopted in the **Network** has been *fruitful*. It has *integrated all* the stakeholders, affiliated members, and ePAGs and could be seen as *an example for other Networks*.

The next steps of the evaluation foresee that the **Network** coordinators and ERN members can send their comments to the Evaluators on the draft evaluation reports and do to this, they have 2 months from the date of reception of the draft report. The FMs evaluated with “Needs improvement” have to develop and submit an improvement plan in the same 2 months period. After These 2 months, final reports will be elaborated by the Evaluators and will be sent to ERNs and to the European Commission.

The **new ERN ReCONNET Grant** will start on *1st September 2023* and it will have *7 beneficiaries and 8 Work Packages*. The grant proposal was submitted on 6th June and the evaluation report is expected by the end of July–August. The signature of the new Grant agreement and the related budget transfer from the European Commission is expected to take place in *February 2024*.

ERN Exchange Program



The **ERN Exchange Program**, launched by the *European Commission (EC)*, is meant to support the sharing of knowledge and stimulate collaboration among the Networks by organising exchange visits and it is fully supported by the funds of the EC.

In particular, **ERN ReCONNET** was allocated 45 “packages” (days of exchange – 1 package=5 days) and *launched 2 calls for interest*: After the first call, 3 exchanges were organised and the program was stopped due to the pandemic; a second call was launched in 2022 and a total of 43 Exchanges were organised out of the 52 received applications.

ERN ReCONNET is the second ERN in terms of number of

packages used.

The program was a great success in ERN ReCONNET, participants have particularly appreciated the opportunity of visiting other ERN centres. Interest on this exchange program was received also from outside the Network (non-ERN members). *The opportunity of organising a new Exchange Program will be discussed in the near future.*
