I have met another reality and a much more pragmatic way to do the follow up of systemic sclerosis patients as was demonstrated to me in Cochin's Hospital. I have broadened my knowledge in the area of systemic sclerosis as well as I had the opportunity to see patients on therapies not yet approved by EMA and not existing in Portugal (e.g. Brodalumab, a considerable number of stem cells transplanted patients).

I pretend to implement what I had learned by presenting a session about my exchange program at my service's weekly meeting.
