The CPMS is a secure IT platform to facilitate cross-border medical discussions and support the ERNs in the diagnosis and treatment of rare and low prevalence complex diseases or conditions.

The platform allows **video** and **chat** discussions, as well as *linking patient files, history or imaging within the platform.*

The module to find as well as invite experts is intuitive and user-friendly.

A **share-screen option** is available to present the case for feedback. The expert advice given is also non-legally binding.

Moreover, **an assistant** can be added to the patient discussion case for an even more practical discussion.
